RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

The Devonridge Farms Dressage Daze Summer Dressage Show is sanctioned as : Bronze competition member of Equine Canada, 308 Legget Drive, Suite 100, Ottawa ON K2K 1Y6 and is governed by the rules of EC.

Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged accordance with the EC Rule Book.

An Equine Canada Bronze (or higher) Membership and an AEF membership are required. Fees should be paid to Equine Canada – www.equinecanada.com and AEF – www.albertaequestrian.com respectively.

Statement of Principle

EC, the National Equestrian Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices;
- Requiring owners, trainers, and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions;
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be cruel, abusive or inhumane.

Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in this EC- sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition.

ENTRY REGULATIONS

1. Entries must be received by July 7th with full payment.
2. Entries may be mailed (Address following entry form), emailed to shelagh.hohm@gmail.com or you may enter online at www.EquestrianEntries.com. If you have requests for ride times please include them on your entry form – ride time or class change requests after the late closing date are subject to a \$20 fee for each change. Changes before July 7 are not subject to a fee.
3. An entry is not considered valid until it has been paid in full. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Cheques or money orders should be made out to Devonridge Farm. Email money transfers are also accepted to shelagh.hohm@gmail.com. Pay Pal is not accepted; please use EqEntries for online payment.
4. Entries received without payment will be considered late. Late entries will be accepted until July 9th and are subject to a late fee.
5. All entries must have the signature of the owner or authorized agent and a signature for the person responsible for the horse. You will not be allowed to ride without a person responsible signature on your entry form.
6. Junior riders must have permission to participate in the show as indicated by the signature of a parent or guardian. The organizing committee reserves the right to limit entries.
7. Entries will be entered on a first come first serve basis. To assure yourself of a place in the shows, please get your entries in early.
8. All athletes, regardless of age or level of competition, must wear properly fitted and fastened safety approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at any EC-sanctioned Dressage competition at the event location. (E.4.0)
9. Hors Concours entries will be accepted with full fees into the Bronze show. Entrants are subject to EC rules, and are not eligible for awards.
10. Horses do not require passports to compete at this show.
11. **Cancellations prior to the closing date will have all fees less the Administration Fee refunded. Cancellations prior to the late closing date with a vets or doctors note will have 50% of the class fees and all other fees less the Administration Fee refunded. Cancellations after the late closing date will have all fees forfeited.**
12. Any horse entered in any class at a competition may, while on the competition grounds, be selected for equine medication control testing. (A602.5)
13. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.
14. The horse may compete at any level up to a maximum of four tests per day.
15. There will be no test readers provided by the show.
16. Any horse receiving less than 50% of the total points obtainable in a test shall not be eligible for awards, ribbons, or prizes. (E9.10.7)

17. When there is only one horse in a class, ribbons and prizes shall be awarded in accordance with the following chart of percentages:

1st - 60% or higher 2nd - 57% to 59.9% 3rd - 54% to 56.9% 4th - 51% to 53.9%

16. No ribbons or prizes shall be awarded below 4 position. (E9.10.10)

17. Equine Canada has all tests and rules available for download on the Equine Canada Website <http://www.equinecanada.ca>.

18. Western Dressage Test of Choice TOC - Western dressage patterns/classes are found on the Western Dressage Associate website, <http://www.westernstyledressage.ca>. Tack rules will follow the Western Dressage Association rules. Helmets are mandatory for all competitors at the Devonridge Dressage Daze show, including Western dressage riders. Western Dressage classes will be run as miscellaneous classes and therefore these classes are not eligible for EC awards.

18. ARTICLE E 4.1.4 BRONZE COMPETITIONS: WALK/TROT THROUGH FOURTH LEVEL

- A dark coloured or grey jacket or tailored dressage vest (tailcoats not permitted). Contrasting collars, pin stripes and piping are allowed.
- Safety approved protective headgear
- White or light coloured breeches
- Juniors are permitted to wear jodhpurs and jodhpur boots.
- Tie, hunting stock, or choker
- Gloves
- Dark coloured riding boots (plain, laced or with zippers)
- Dark coloured half chaps or half boots zipped over short boots may be worn.
- Spurs are optional. See E 4.1.8.

19. ARTICLE E 4.1.1 FEI TESTS FROM YOUNG RIDER TO GRAND PRIX IN ALL EC SANCTIONED COMPETITIONS INCLUDING CHAMPIONSHIPS

- A dark coloured or grey jacket (short or tailcoat) or tailored dressage vest. Contrasting collars, pin stripes and piping are allowed.
- Safety approved protective headgear.
- White or off-white breeches
- Tie or hunting stock
- Gloves
- Dark coloured riding boots (plain, laced or with zippers)
- Spurs are optional. See E 4.1.8.

20. ARTICLE E 4.1.2 FEI CHILDREN, FEI PONY AND FEI JUNIOR TESTS IN ALL EC SANCTIONED COMPETITIONS

- A dark coloured or grey jacket, club uniform coat or tailored dressage vest. Contrasting collars, pin stripes and piping are allowed.
- Safety approved protective headgear.
- White or light coloured breeches or jodhpurs with jodhpur boots
- Tie, hunting stock or choker
- Gloves

- Dark coloured riding boots (plain, laced or with zippers)
- Note: Spurs are optional, but if used, FEI Child spurs may not be longer than 1.5 cm. FEI Pony athletes' spurs may not be longer than 3.5 cm.
- Note: For FEI Child or Pony classes, spurs are optional, but if used, only blunt metal spurs no longer than 3.5 cm are allowed. Rowels on spurs are not allowed.

Ribbons:

There will be no mounted presentations. Ribbons (to 4th place) by category of rider will be handed out with tests.

Awards:

The following special awards are offered:

Junior High Point (Highest single score achieved by a Junior Rider in any class except the Prix Caprilli)

Adult Amateur High Point (Highest single score achieved by an Amateur Rider in any class except the Prix Caprilli)

Prix Caprilli High Point (Highest single score achieved in the Prix Caprilli classes)

Schooling Times:

Warm up in the show ring will be allowed on Friday from 2:00 PM until 7:00 PM for all horses. Horses that are not stabled on the grounds may also come on Friday and school in the rings. There will be posted warm ups in the indoor sand ring throughout the show day.

Riding Times:

Show correspondence will be handled through email. Ride times will be posted at www.foxvillage.com as soon as they are available. Ride times will also be posted at the show office. Riders are responsible for checking the day sheets as ride times may change. Please provide a correct email on your entry form.

Stabling:

A limited number of stalls will be available on a first requested basis for Friday night and Saturday. Shavings will also be available for purchase on site.

Directions & Parking:

Access to Parking lot will be off of Graminia Road in the pasture.

Devonridge Farm is located on the NW corner of Range Road #272 and Graminia Road (Twp Rd #511). From Devon – Hwy #60, Turn West on Graminia Road and just past Range Road #272 (200 ft) you will see the parking signs on the north side of the road.

From Spruce Grove – Turn south on Golden Spike Road (Range Road #272) to Graminia Road (Twp Rd #511) Turn East on Graminia Road and go almost one mile. You will see the Parking Signs going into the pasture just BEFORE Range Road #272 on the North side of the road which is where you will turn in.
